- Competitions will be held on Tuesday, 16th September 2025 from 10:00 am onwards and prizes will be distributed on the same day at same venue after competitions.
- Venue for all the contests will be Adisankaranilayam at Veliyanad (off Peppathy Jr., 3 kms. Before Piravom on Ernakulam – Piravom road).
- The accompanying teachers (not students) may collect chest-numbers for his/her team of students at 08:30 – 09:30 an on 16th September 2025 from CIFSS office.
- All communications will be posted in the whats App group, “**Samskrutotsavah-2025**”. Participating students or their parents and teachers can join this group.
- Contests are open to all bona-fied school students.
- List of participants has to be forwarded by the head of the institutions.
- Every school can send two (only 2) participants for each item, except mentioned otherwise.
- One student can participate in a maximum of three (only 3) items.
- If parents want to bring in their children studying in a particular school where from no teacher is accompanying, then, a bona-fied letter promptly singed and sealed by the head of school stating the age or standard of the student, on its letter-head, along with the registration form should reach us on or before 2nd September 2025.
- Change of registered participants' name, proxy and spot registrations are not allowed.
- Mere participation is not an entitlement for prise and the decision of the judging panel is final.
- Food will be served to all the registered participants and accompanying teacher/ parent.
